#### **Introduction**

The World Bank in Togo is offering a six months internship from April to September 2023 to help support the work of the country office.

#### **1. Objectives of the internship**

The candidate must be registered for PhD thesis in Economics, Statistics, or related field. Good knowledge of statistical and econometric tools, analytical ability required and good basic knowledge of English desirable.

The intern will work under the supervision of the country manager.

The intern will be required to produce a report at the end of the internship period.
